

Disciplinary Committee of the Royal Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain

The Disciplinary Committee met on Tuesday 22 June 2010, Wednesday 23 June 2010 and Thursday 24 June 2010 and made the following directions:

1. Following an application for restoration to the Register of Pharmacists on behalf of Mr John Wesley Gilpin (previous registration number: 1055670), the Committee directed on Tuesday 22 June 2010, that Mr Gilpin's application be refused.
2. Following an application for restoration to the Register of Pharmacists on behalf of Mr Rashad Arif (previous registration number: 106922437), the Committee directed on Wednesday 23 June 2010, that Mr Arif's application be adjourned to a future date.
3. On Thursday 24 June 2010, the Disciplinary Committee considered an application for restoration to the Register of Pharmacists on behalf of Mr Ian Anthony McAsey (previous registration number: 85173). The Committee directed that Mr McAsey's application be granted subject to his compliance with the following requirements:
 - i) That within the next 12 months, he completes a Return to Practice course and lodges with the Society a certificate that he has completed such a course; and
 - ii) That until the certificate has been lodged, he is not to work as a single handed practitioner and/or Superintendent Pharmacist, and/or Responsible Pharmacist.

The above direction means that Mr McAsey is not to work on his own.

In accordance with article 56 of the Pharmacists and Pharmacy Technicians Order 2007, Mr McAsey has the right to appeal the Committee's decision to the Court.

4. On Thursday 24 June 2010, the Disciplinary Committee made an order under Article 54 of the Pharmacists and Pharmacy Technicians Order 2007 and Rule 39(2) of the Royal Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain (Fitness to Practise and Disqualification etc Rules) Order 2007, that the registration of Miss Jennifer Victoria Drennan (Registration number: 1054486) be suspended for a period of 18 months. The Committee directed that the order take effect immediately. This order is subject to review within 6 months.
