REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION IN JAMAICA

Pharmacists registered with the Society are eligible for registration in Jamaica and should apply to the Pharmacy Council. You will be required:

- a) to request that the Society issue direct to the Pharmacy Council a certificate of identity confirming your registration and good standing;
- b) provide certified copies of your experience from your employers since graduation.

Having satisfied the Pharmacy council in respect of the above, you will be required to undertake a written and oral examination set by the Council.

We have recently been advised that the registration process for pharmacists in Jamaica is under review, even though no major changes are envisaged it is advisable that all potential applicants contact the Pharmacy Council for the most up to date registration procedure.
