

There follows the outcome of recent Inquiries heard before the Statutory Committee of the Royal Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain.

Monday 25, Tuesday 26, Wednesday 27 and Thursday 28 September 2006:

1. Following the Inquiry into a complaint by the Council of the Society against Mr [Omotayo Enitan Adekaiyaoja](#) (Registration no. 1062304) (*see also* [Alert notice](#)), Mr [Martyn James Hardy](#) (Registration no. 71137) and [Sainsbury's Supermarkets Ltd](#) (Identification no. 1003528), the Committee resolved to take no further action against Mr Hardy or Sainsbury's Supermarkets Ltd. In relation to Mr Adekaiyaoja, the Committee resolved to direct the removal of his name from the Register. The Committee found proved the Council's allegation that the supply of Methadone mixture otherwise than in accordance with the direction on a prescription, a number of erroneous supplies by Mr Adekaiyaoja or whilst he was the pharmacist in charge, an erroneous supply of Porcine Isophane Insulin 30/70 to a patient and a failure to deal with the error appropriately, and a poor understanding of diabetes and its treatment, amounted to misconduct. Under Section 11 of the Pharmacy Act 1954, the direction to remove Mr Adekaiyaoja's name from the Register is not to take effect until the expiration of a period of three months from the date on which notice of removal was given or in a case where an appeal has been brought against the direction, until the appeal is determined or withdrawn.
2. The Inquiry into a complaint by the Council of the Society against Mr Korush Jalali Farahani (Registration no. 1067185) was adjourned to resume at a later date.
3. The Committee adjourned the Inquiry into a complaint by the Council of the Society against Mr Samuel Edwin Ashby (Registration no. R6879) to deliver their determination at a later date.
